Robert E. Strom, of Southington, CT passed away on July 29, 2021 at the age of 91. He was born in Middletown CT on December 16, 1929 to Sigfrid and Mildred (Champion) Strom and was raised in Cromwell. He was the youngest and last surviving of 7 siblings.
